

Requirements for in-person, off-SUUC-campus gatherings based on WA State Phase 2 Mandates and CDC Guidelines.

- In general, the more people you interact with, the more closely you interact with them, and the longer that interaction, the higher the risk of COVID-19 spread.
- Delay or cancel a visit if you or your visitors have symptoms of COVID-19 or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- In-home gatherings are permitted to convene up to 5 individuals in Phase 2. These individuals do not need to be from the same household. However, individuals must wear face coverings when individuals from outside of the household participate.
- Encourage social distancing of at least 6 feet during your visit.
- Visit with your friends and family outdoors, when possible. If this is not feasible, make sure the room or space is well-ventilated (for example, open windows or doors) and large enough to accommodate social distancing.
- Arrange tables and chairs to allow for social distancing. People from the same household can be in groups together and don't need to be 6 feet apart from each other.
- Try to avoid close contact with your visitors. For example, don't shake hands, elbow bump, or hug. Instead wave and verbally greet them.
- If possible, avoid others who are not wearing masks or ask others around you to wear masks.
- Keep a list of people you visited or who visited you and when the visit occurred. This will help with contact tracing if someone becomes sick.

People of any age with the following conditions are at increased risk of severe illness from COVID-19 and should limit their interactions with other people as much as possible:

Cancer, chronic kidney disease, COPD, immunocompromised state, obesity, serious heart conditions, Sickle cell disease, and Type 2 diabetes mellitus.
