Saltwater Unitarian Universalist Church COVID-19 Safety Requirements for Outdoor Church-Sponsored Activities

Scope

These requirements apply to outdoor services and other activities on the organization's property (or immediately adjacent property if explicitly permitted by the local jurisdiction)

General Requirements

- In phase 2, up to 200 individuals may participate; the maximum number of participants increases to 400 in phase 3.
- An attendance list, including event name, date, and attendee names and contact information, must be completed and retained for 2 weeks to enable contact with each participant in the event of any COVID-19 exposure. (WA Phase 2 & 3 guidelines).
- One person must be assigned to ensure all participants complete the attendance sheet, that the list is kept for the required 2 weeks, and the SUUC contact person is informed of any COVID-19 cases.
- Those with symptoms of COVID-19--fever over 100.4 degrees F, cough, shortness of breath, loss
 of taste or smell, aches not caused by injury, severe headache, sore throat, nausea or vomiting-may not participate and are strongly encouraged to self-isolate at home and consult their
 medical provider regarding COVID-19 testing.
- For each activity there must be a designated individual who will ensure participants are maintaining social distancing, wearing masks, and following disinfection requirements.
- Six feet of physical distancing must be maintained between households.
- Cloth face coverings are required for all participants.
- Outdoor services may be conducted under an outdoor structure (temporary or permanent) so long as the structure is not walled/enclosed on more than two sides to provide appropriate ventilation.

Food and Supplies

- Individuals must provide their own food and drink, and social distancing between households must be maintained during consumption.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes must be readily available for use during the event.
- It is strongly recommended that participants provide their own tools or other supplies; shared tools and supplies must be disinfected between users.

Restrooms

Access

- Due to extensive disinfection requirements, restrooms in the welcoming room will be available for <u>urgent use only</u>.
- Entry to, and exit from, the welcoming room is via the back door (with access code) only. Please sanitize hands before entering.
- Individuals must maintain physical/social distancing at all times while in the building. (WA requirement #4)
- Every person must wear a face mask or face covering while inside the church building. (WA requirement #3)
- Before exiting the welcoming room, individuals must wipe down any surfaces touched (e.g., light switches, door handles, door locks)
- Restroom access is limited to 2 people at a time. (WA requirement #6)
- Individuals waiting to use the restroom must maintain at least 6 feet of distance between each person. (WA requirement #6)

Restroom disinfection

- Disinfectant wipes, hand-washing soap, and hand sanitizer will be provided in each restroom (WA requirement #8)
- Individuals must personally wipe down surfaces—including, but not limited to, door handles, door push plates, light switches, toilet seats, sinks, faucets, and counter tops—prior to and after using the facilities.
- Individuals must wash their hands after using the facilities
- Used disinfectant wipes must be placed in the receptacle provided and discarded in the outside garbage bin at the end of the event.
- Restrooms must be cleaned and sanitized after the event (WA requirement #9); wear disposable gloves and clean surfaces with soap and water, then use disinfectants. (WA requirements #7 & 8)
