Donations for Refugee Families

Haitian Christians United, our partner at Saltwater, is providing support for refugee families coming from Haiti across the US-Mexico border. In the last three months they have welcomed 20 families, and they anticipate at least 12 more families coming to King County to settle. The Racial Justice Organizing Team at Saltwater is partnering with Haitian Christians United to provide support to families of essential needs.

Below is a list of in-kind donations which can be dropped off on Saturday, September 11th at our outdoor ingathering event. There will be two drop off locations: in the main parking lot and by the church office. If you have larger donations, please plan to drop them at the station in the parking lot. There will also be a station for creating and signing cards of welcome!

In-kind donation needs (new only please): cleaning wipes, hand soap, hand sanitizer, body lotion, soap/body wash, toothpaste, toothbrushes, bath towels, feminine pads/products, razors, deodorant, baby wipes, diapers (6 months through toddler), combs, hair brushes, toilet paper, paper towels, and washcloths.
